# 1 About this user guide

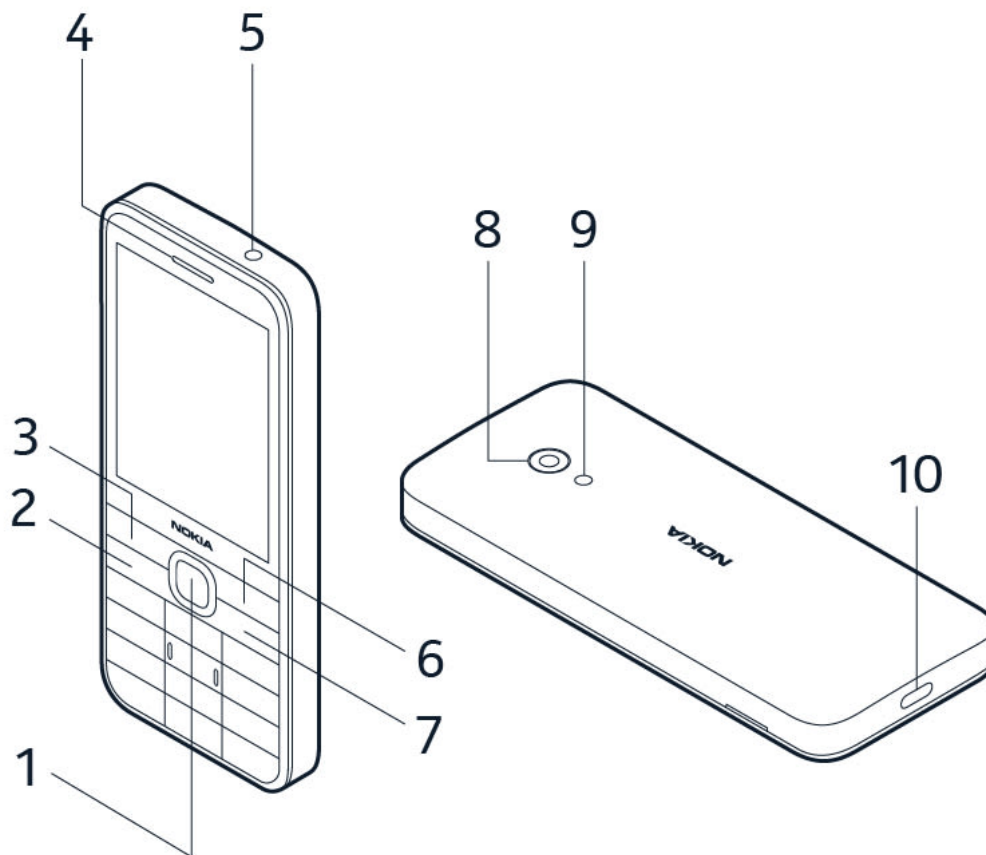

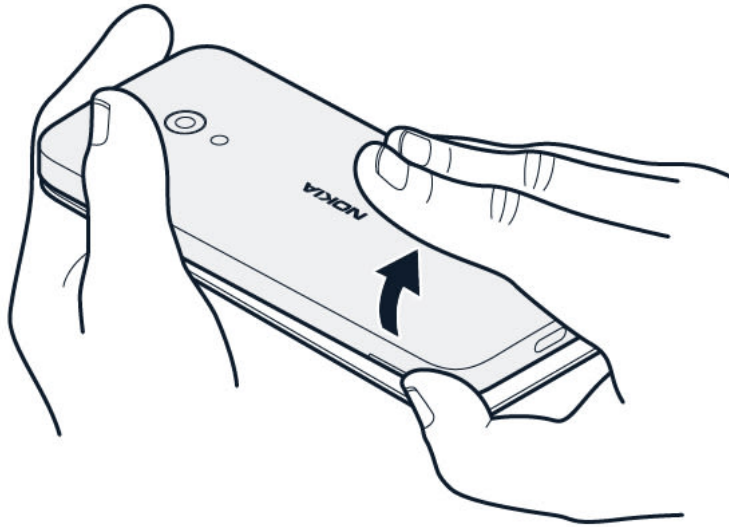
Some of the accessories mentioned in this user guide, such as charger, headset, or data cable, may be sold separately.



**Note:** You can set the phone to ask for a security code. Select [Menu](#) > [Settings](#) > [Security](#) > [Keyguard](#) > [Security code](#), and enter a code. Note, however, that you need to remember the code, as HMD Global is not able to open or bypass it.

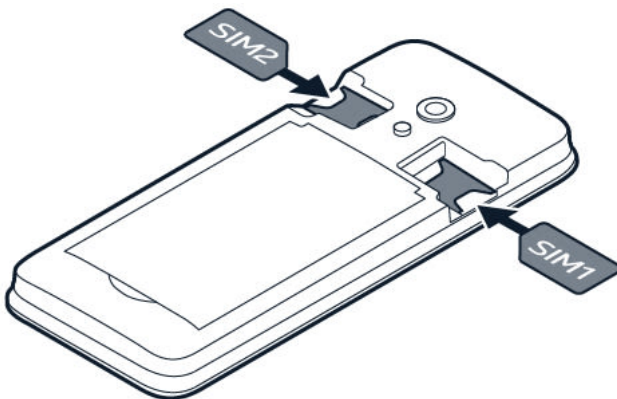


## Open the back cover



1. Put your fingernail in the small slot at the side of the phone, lift and remove the cover.
2. If the battery is in the phone, lift it out.

## Insert the SIM cards



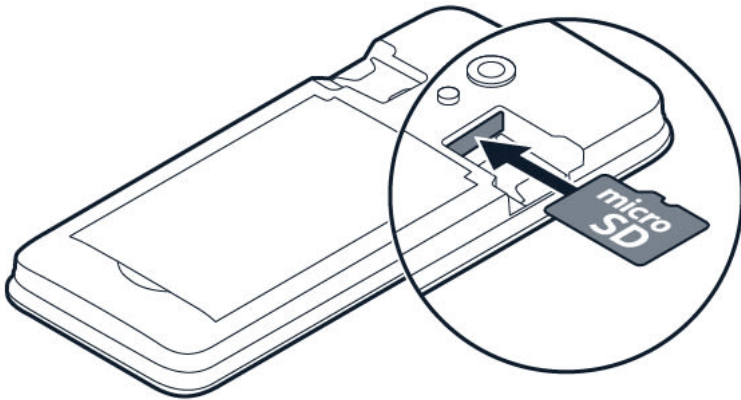
1. Slide the SIM card in the SIM card slot.
2. If you have a dual-SIM phone, slide the second SIM in the SIM2 slot.

Both SIM cards are available at the same time when the device is not being used, but while one SIM card is active, for example, making a call, the other may be unavailable.



**Tip:** To find out if your phone can use 2 SIM cards, see the label on the sales box. If there are 2 IMEI codes on the label, you have a dual-SIM phone.

## Insert the memory card



1. Slide the memory card in the memory card slot.
2. Put back the battery.
3. Put back the back cover.

Use only compatible memory cards approved for use with this device. Incompatible cards may damage the card and the device and corrupt data stored on the card.



**Tip:** Use a fast, up to 32 GB microSD memory card from a well-known manufacturer.

## KEYPAD

### Use the phone keys

- To see the apps and features of your phone, on the home screen, select **Menu**.
- To go to an app or feature, press the scroll key up, down, left, or right. To open the app or feature, press the scroll key.
- If you have selected the zoomed menu view, press the scroll key up or down to go to an app or feature. To open the app or feature, press the scroll key.

### Lock the keypad

To lock the keys, select **Lock keypad**. To unlock the keys, select **Unlock**, and press \*.

### Write with the keypad

Press a key repeatedly until the letter is shown.

To type in a space press **0**.

To type in a special character or punctuation mark, press the asterisk key, or if you are using predictive text, press and hold the # key.

To switch between character cases, press **#** repeatedly.

To type in a number, press and hold a number key.

## CONTACTS

### Add a contact

1. Select **Menu** > **Contacts** > **≡** > **Add new contact**.
2. Select where to save the contact.
3. Write the name, and type in the number.
4. Select **≡** > **Save contact**.

### Save a contact from the call logs

1. Select **Menu** > **Call logs**, and select the call type.
2. Scroll to the number you want to save and select **≡** > **Add to contacts** > **New contact**.
3. Select where to save the contact.
4. Add the contact details and select **≡** > **Save contact**.


### Call a contact

You can call a contact directly from the contacts list.

Select **Menu** > **Contacts**, scroll to the contact you want to call, and press the call key.

## SEND MESSAGES

### Write and send messages

1. Select **Menu** > **Messages** > **+ New message**.
2. Type in a phone number, or press  and select a recipient from your contacts list.
3. Write your message.
4. To insert symbols to the message, press \*.
5. Select **Send**. If asked, select which SIM to use.

### CHANGE TONES

#### Set new tones

1. Select **Menu** > **Settings** > **Profiles**, scroll to a profile and select **≡** > **Settings** > **Ring settings**.
2. Select which tone you want to change.
3. Scroll to the tone that you want and select **Select**.

### CHANGE THE LOOK OF YOUR HOME SCREEN

#### Choose a new wallpaper

You can change the background of your home screen.

1. Select **Menu** > **Settings** > **Personalisation** > **Lock screen background** > **Wallpapers**.
2. Select the wallpaper you want.

### PROFILES

#### Set a profile

There are several profiles that you can use in different situations. There is, for example, a silent profile for when you cannot have sounds on, and an outdoor profile with loud tones.

1. Select **Menu** > **Settings** > **Profiles**.
2. To adjust a profile, scroll to it, and select **≡** > **Settings**. Change the settings you want.
3. To set on a profile, scroll to it, and select **Select**.

### PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

#### Take a photo

1. Select **Menu** > **Camera**.
2. To zoom in or out, scroll up or down.
3. To take a photo, press the scroll key.

To see the photo you just took, on the home screen, select **Menu** > **Gallery**.

#### Record a video

1. To switch the video camera on, select **Menu** > **Camera** and scroll to .
2. To start recording, press the scroll key.
3. To stop recording, select .

To see the video you just recorded, on the home screen, select **Menu** > **Videos**.

### SET THE TIME AND DATE MANUALLY

#### Change the time and date

1. Select **Menu** > **Settings** > **Time & language** > **Date and time**.
2. Select **Auto-update** > **Change**.

5. Select **Date** and enter the date.
6. Select **Save**.

### ALARM CLOCK

#### Set an alarm

1. Select **Menu** > **Alarm**.
2. Select **New alarm** and enter the alarm time and other details.

### CALENDAR

#### Add a calendar event

1. Select **Menu** > **Extras** > **Calendar**.
2. Scroll to a date, and select **≡** > **Add new event**.
3. Enter the event name and other details, and select **Save**.

### CALCULATOR

#### Use the calculator

1. Select **Menu** > **Extras** > **Calculator**.
2. Enter the first factor of your calculation, use the scroll key to select the operation, and enter the second factor.
3. Press the scroll key to get the result of the calculation.

Select **☒** to empty the number fields.













temperatures and lose enough power to switch off the phone within minutes. When you are outdoors in cold temperatures, keep your phone warm.
